
Overview

Lack of access to resources to is one of the biggest barriers educators face in enacting high-quality STEM learning experiences in their classrooms. The STEM Shoppe Learning Series teaches educators how to use learning resources from our STEM Shoppe in their classrooms. Educators can then borrow the materials for free through our STEM Shoppe Loan Program.

The aims of this Learning Series are:

- 150 unique educators access curriculum and resources that help them enact high-quality STEM experiences.
- 100% of participating educators will report feeling more competent and confident in the relevant STEM content area and increase their knowledge of STEM practices and implementation strategies.
- 50% of participating educators will serve students from underrepresented populations.
