### CHOOSE A PROJECT

**Before registering, choose a research category for your project.** Each category is judged separately, and winners are selected within their field. Categories with fewer than five entries may be combined with similar ones.

- Animal Science

**Complete Your Paperwork:** Before any research begins, it is imperative that all students complete the necessary forms to guarantee ethical and safe research practices. Each project requires the following forms at minimum:

- Adult Sponsor Checklist (1)
- Research Plan/Project Summary
- Student Checklist (1A)
- Approval Form (1B)

**For Teachers:** Register as a Teacher and create accounts for each Student.

**Student Teams:** Each student must have their own account. Select "Team Project" and enter your teammates' names.

- Follow your research plan and record your results.
- Ask mentors, teachers, or TRSA staff for help anytime you need it.
- Organize your data so it's easy to explain what you discovered.
